NO ONE IS ILLEGAL!

No detention and deportation centers: NO CPR here or elsewhere. NO Minniti-Orlando and Bossi-Fini law.

Freedom to move and to stay. Immigrant visa regardless of the Employment Contract. Home, income, work rights, welfare, residence, citizenship rights now!

In Montichiari, near Brescia, the government wants to open a CPR: a center to detain and deport migrants people who, because of the laws, did not obtain immigrant visa or lost it after losing their job.

It is very difficult to have regular documents in Italy and, even if you can get them, you must always wait and living in uncertainty: for permission, renewal, family reunification, residence, citizenship.

We do not want to get used to this approved system: immigrant people who are insulted and humiliated, forced to be clandestine. Exploitation and precarious work. Trained solidarity. Suffering and dying for those who are not yet part of this country and trying to reach it.

The European and Italian institutions are building barriers to not enter those who run away from wars and poverty caused by the colonial bullying of Europe. They deny people who manages to get there. They deal with suspicion and discrimination immigrant people who have been here for so long.

Women and men that are migrant have the right to stay here! They have hopes and dreams. They have their dignity to defend. They want to live! No racism!
