

NO TO SALVINI'S LAW AND RACISM - YES TO RIGHTS BIG DEMONSTRATION

Saturday 4th of May at 3pm piazza Rovetta (Largo Formentone), Brescia

Minister Salvini and the government feed discrimination, contempt and hatred against immigrants.

A new law wanted by Salvini increases denials of residence permits and illegal immigration. It increases time, costs and obstacles to get citizenship, which can also be revoked. It increases expulsions and deteriorates living conditions in centers for asylum seekers and their families. It increases the detention of immigrants without a permit in former CIE (now called CPR). It also send to prison homeless people who occupy empty buildings and workers who strike blocking roads.

Salvini's law is against immigrants, but also against all poor people and workers, both immigrants and Italians.

All immigrants, asylum seekers or not, have the same problems and want the same rights: documents and permits; hospitality, house, work, health care, decent social services. No more long waiting periods, no more denials, no more expulsions, no more racism. **Let's unite! Stop being afraid! No one can save himself alone!**
